

Setting up your Alliant direct deposit is as simple as:

Option 1: Ask your employer if they have a direct deposit form. They probably do! If they do, use the Alliant Account information below to complete it!

Option 2: If they don't have a direct deposit form, you can use the below form instead. Make sure you

- · Complete the entire form
- · Sign and date it
- · Give it to your employer

That's it! Keep in mind that it may take one to two pay periods for your payroll department to set up your direct deposit. Please contact your company for more details. In the meantime, use our Alliant Mobile App to deposit your paper checks or set up a transfer between your Alliant account and your other bank.
